Oil based emulsion suitable for the use in the feather of heavy horse breeds for the improvement of the condition to the hair and skin and the repellent of the Chorioptes Bovis mite (feather mite),

including all biting lice and flying insects.

Suitable for all skin types, including sore, cracked heels and knees, an **accumulation of thickened, crusted scale and scabs** on the front and hind legs of horses; with antiseptic properties.

To act as a barrier between skin and the hair, against the elements.

Emulsion – Ready for use.

- 1. Only apply the product to dry legs; (if you wish to wash the feather prior to application, it advisable to do so the day before to avoid locking in any moisture) brush out any loose hair or dirt prior to application (please read below about patch testing).
- 2. Shake the container before use, use the trigger spray supplied or pour the liquid into a bowl, PLEASE NOTE Only a small amount is need and should be applied evenly through the hair and not in large quantities. Apply approximatley 100ml 200ml (on all four legs), using a brush or disposable gloved hand. Apply in a back comb motion into the hair, ensuring application on to the skin and into the heels, up to the knee front and back, (apply a small amount directly onto areas of sore skin).

Use the product to remove any skin debris loose in the horses feather.

- 3. It is advisable to apply the product on day 1, day 4 and then re-apply on a fortnightly basis for care and preventative measures.
- 4. It is recommended that where possible, the product be left applied as long as possible before washing out and that it be left in for a minimum of 14 days, however it is not essential to wash out the product at any interval, providing the application instructions have been followed, (please read warnings below regarding sun exposure).

When the time comes to shampoo the product from the feather, it is advised to use warm water where possible, a shampoo purposful to washing horses and that the shampoo be left in the hair for approximatley 30 minutes prior to rinsing to help lift the oil (combing throught the hair with a conditioning shampoo will help to clean the feather).

Mitey Feathers is NOT like using Pig Oil (mineral oil) – DO NOT APPLY TOO MUCH! It is recommended to apply as if applying hair treatment oil to your own hair, evenly to each strand and across the surface of the skin.
