

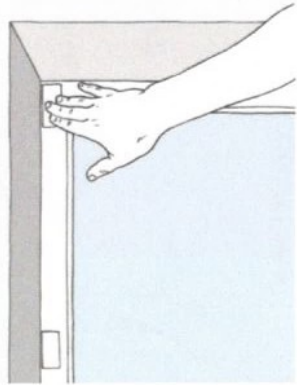

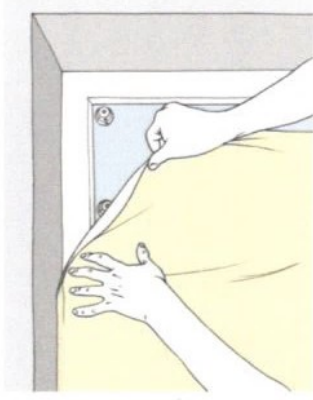

## Great blackout in 2 easy steps:

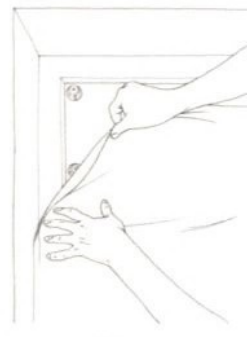
1. Apply suction cups to the window glass, or self-adhesive attachments to the frame, or a combination of both
  2. Press your blackout fabric against either to attach
- Remove and replace as required

**Step 1: OPTIONAL** Using sharp scissors, cut your blackout fabric to the shape and size required, ensuring that the fabric is larger than the window recess. There should be an excess of approx. 2cm (3/4inch) on each of the four sides so that the fabric 'folds around' and sits against the window recess. This helps to achieve the best degree of blackout. Alternatively you can simply allow the excess fabric to hang downwards.

**Step 2:** Make sure the window is completely clean - some cleaning products can leave a residue, so rinsing with water can help. Press the suction cups to the glass, and/or the Frame Fasteners to the window frame, with at least one in each corner, and additional suction cups at intervals along the top and sides as required



**Step 3:** Press the reverse side of your go anywhere or easyblackout fabric against the attachments on the window to attach your blackout blind. It is best to orientate the fabric so that any large excess hangs down, rather than out to the sides.

To remove, peel the fabric gently away from the attachments on the window.

**SAFETY - PLEASE NOTE:** As this products is used to cover the window, it is essential to ensure that there is always sufficient ventilation in a baby or child's bedroom. If used with small children, do not place directly over a bed, or where it may be pulled down by a child.
